Subject: Exchange Program with St Andrew's Episcopal School, Jackson- Mississippi, USA

Sreenidhi International school is happy to announce the student-faculty exchange programme with St. Andrew's Episcopal School, Mississippi (<http://www.gosaints.org/>) during the month of October 2017. The dates for travel are from 24th September, 2017 - 7th October, 2017.

Exchange programmes between schools located in different countries give opportunities to staff and students to understand closely the different cultures of the world, understand one's role as a global citizen, and inculcate leadership qualities. St. Andrew's Episcopal School, Jackson, Mississippi, USA, has a high reputation in their country for quality education, excellent standards in providing valuable education and community service. The programme is well-designed and carefully planned keeping in mind the student age groups involved. Accommodations for staff and students is planned along with the host families, students participate in teaching and learning through observation, hold discussions with the members of the school community and visit places of historic and cultural importance.

It is our endeavour to provide opportunities to students to acquire a global perspective through first-hand experience by interacting with students and teachers of other schools in different countries. The School Management has tied-up with schools in the U.S.A. for exchange programmes.

Details of the programme:

1. Students and parents are required to fill-in the given form to register their name for the exchange programme.
2. The students who register for this programme will attend an individual counselling session by our Pedagogical Leadership Team, to assess the suitability of the student for the programme.
3. A group of eight students and two faculty members from Sreenidhi International School will be travelling to Mississippi, USA.
4. Please note that only students having a valid passport (expiry of the passport should be on or after 30 April, 2018) will be considered for the travel.
5. Selection of students to this programme will be on first come first served basis, as the number of students who will be travelling to USA is limited and will depend on the availability of number of host parents at their end.
6. The Parents who wish to send their ward for the exchange programme, will be required to pay **Rs 1,95,000/-** in cheque/draft, drawn in favour of "**Sreenidhi International School**", which includes airfare, visa charges, insurance and the cost involved in the sight-seeing tours organized by the host school. You are requested to pay the amount on or before **31th May, 2017**. In case your child is having a valid U.S.A visit visa or a U.S.A. Passport, the cost payable is Rs. 1,83,000/-.
